## Health Care Resources

- What to do if you are feeling sick?
  - Stay home.
  - Review the Eagle County - COVID-19 Symptoms Report Form [www.eaglecounty.us/selfreport](http://www.eaglecounty.us/selfreport) and fill out if you are experiencing any of the included symptoms.

- Should I get tested?
  - Testing may not be needed for all patients or may be limited for persons with mild illness. Call your health care provider first to determine if testing is recommended. Do not show up at a testing facility without a confirmed appointment.
  - Individuals at high-risk (over 60 or with underlying medical conditions) that have symptoms should contact their Primary Care Physician for testing.
